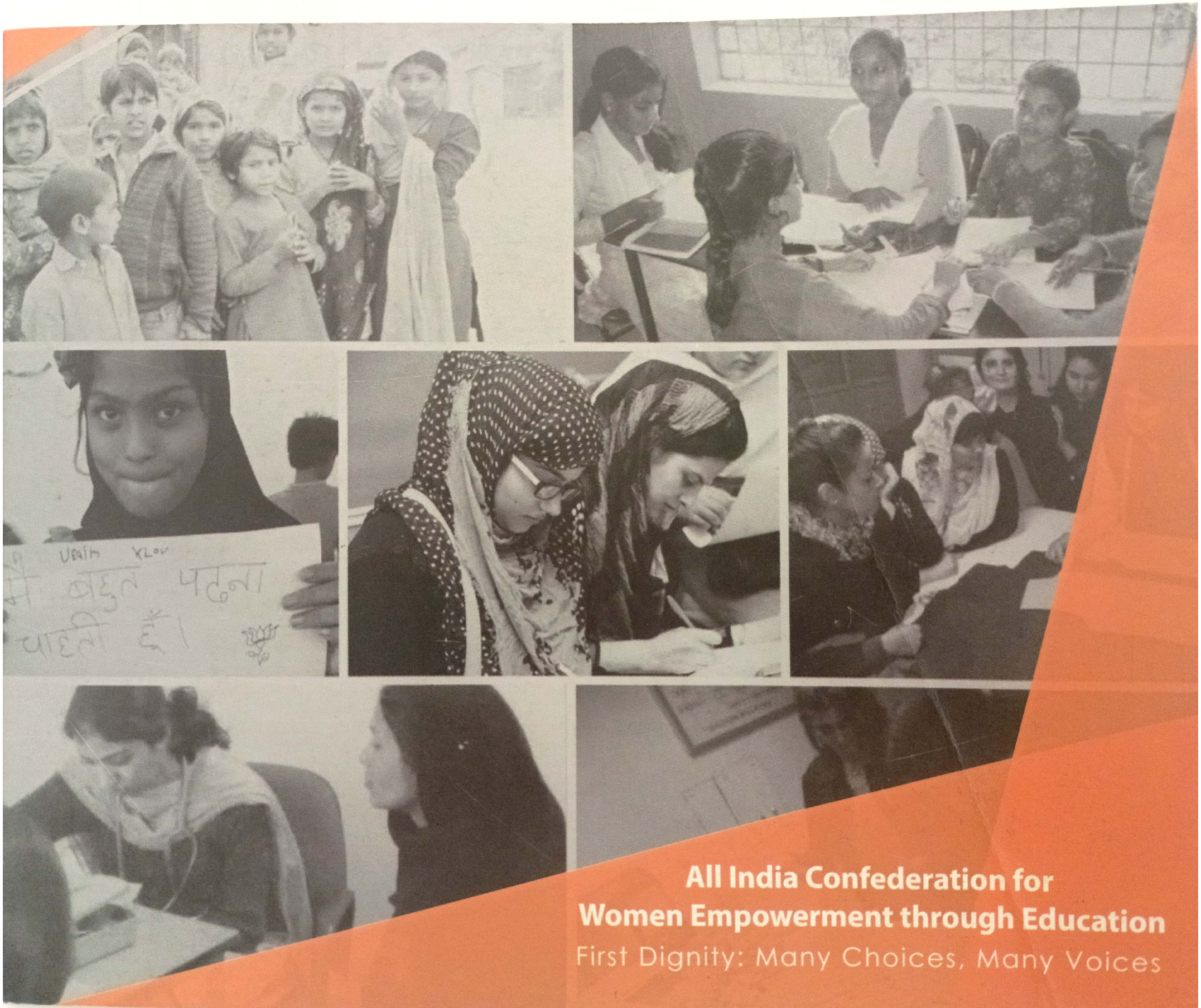
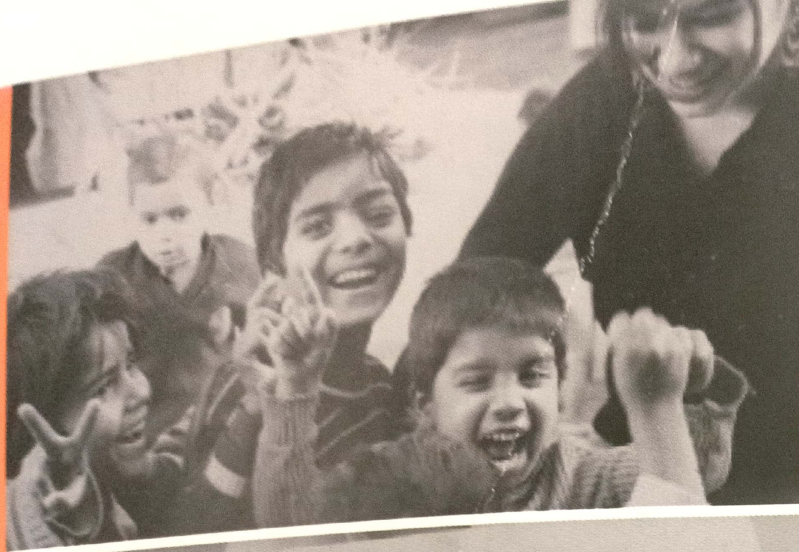

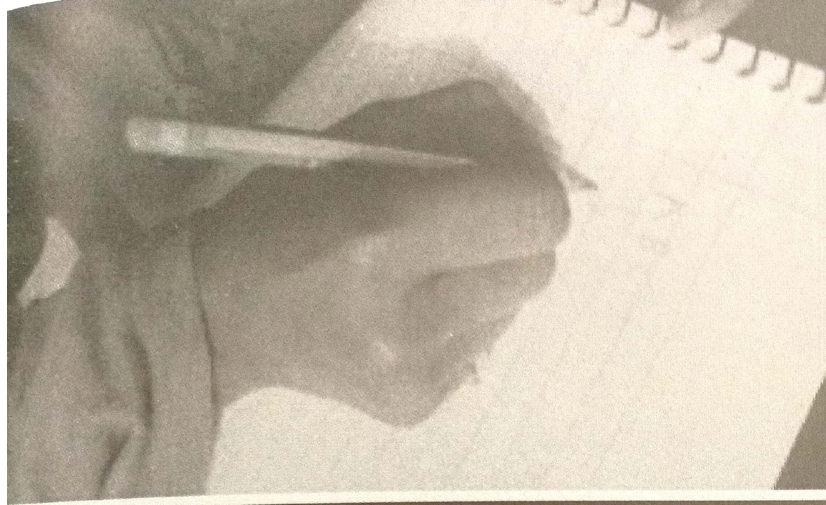

AICWETE works with a vision to restore dignity of poorest of the poor by giving them opportunities and resources to raise their voices and make appropriate choices for creating a better world for themselves. Most of the initiatives of the organisation aim to empower socio economically marginalized groups of society, especially women for unleashing their creativity, wisdom and allowing them to be fully equipped with economic capital and social wherewithal to climb up on the social ladder. One of the core beliefs of the organisation has been empowering through education and skilling to nudge people out of vicious cycle of poverty and make them socio-economically self-reliant. But, the organisation also believes that it cannot be done in isolation. Hence, AICWETE supports and networks with many small scale local NGOs and Community based organisation in reaching out to people across the country. It is crucial because the diversity which Indian subcontinent juxtaposes in its entirety and the contextual needs of a development programme, creates a space for partnership with multiple groups/individuals/institutions to fulfill multifaceted development agenda of the country in a cohesive manner. Many a times the organisation has been receiving laurels due to its relentless efforts to leverage resources for supporting people/ institutions working at the grassroots and policy advocacy in favour of women and children.



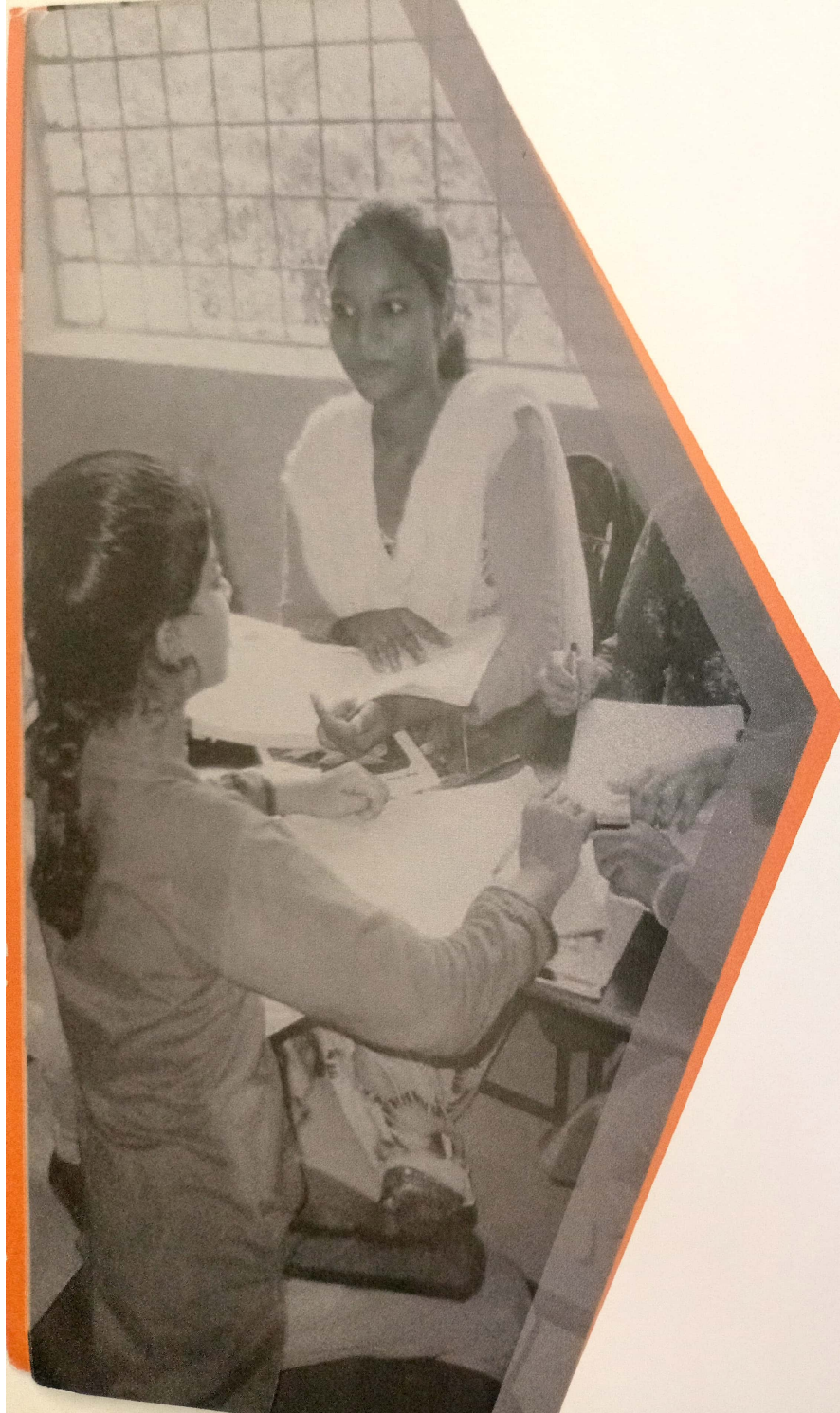

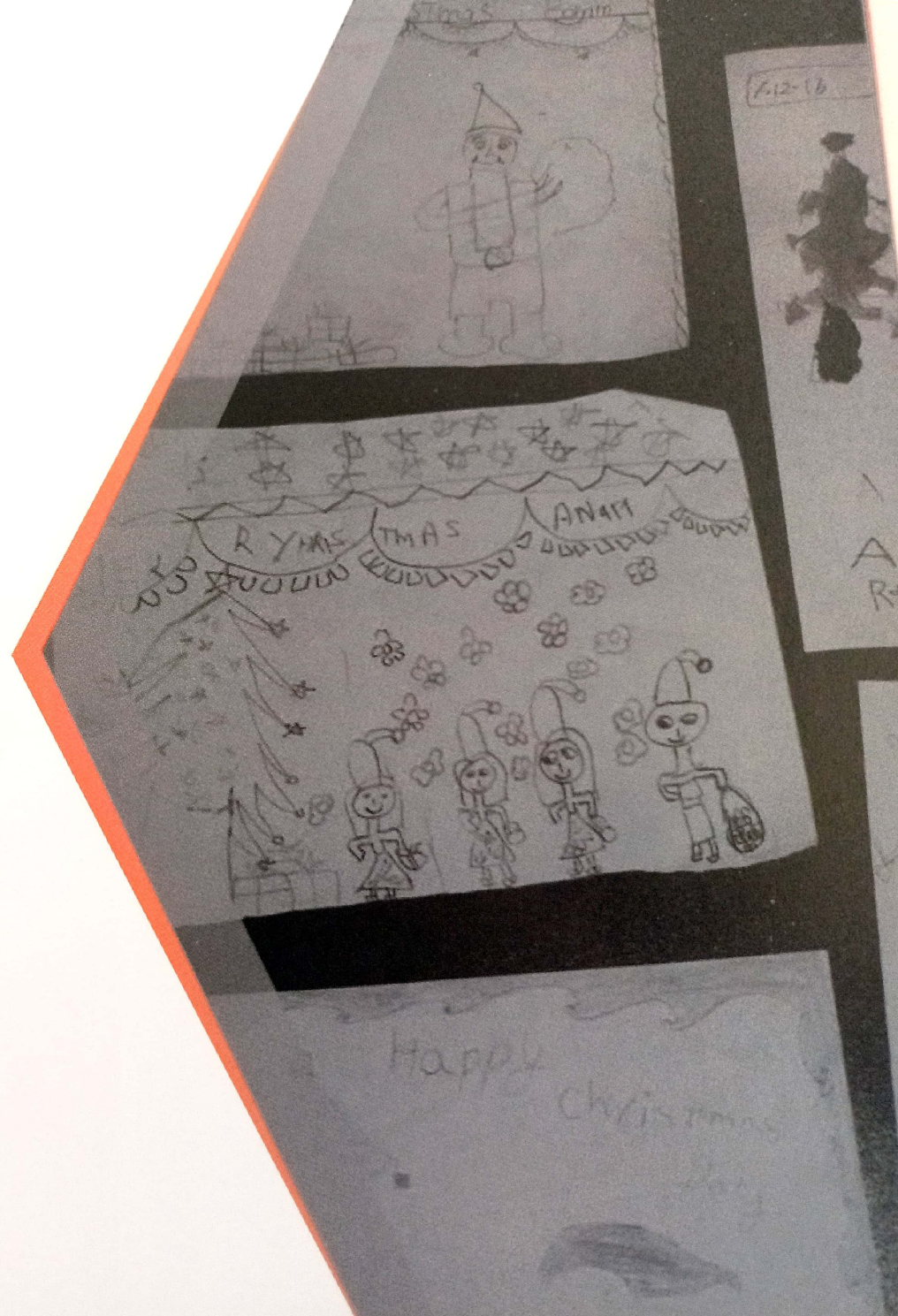




EDUCATION

AICWETE works to ensure equitable quality education for all not only through its direct implementation projects but also by creating a favourable socio-systemic environment for the implementation of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2010. Fully mindful about the role education plays in carving future for larger human well-being, AICWETE works on the continuum of education ranging from early childhood care and developmental initiatives to support higher education system across the country. Through several programmes, the organization has tried to reach out to various marginalized communities in different states such as Assam Delhi – NCR, Haryana, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana, Jammu & Kashmir and Uttar Pradesh.

After supporting many CBOs for area development for years, AICWETE has initiated a direct implementation programme '**Remedial cum Education Contact Point**' - '**UROOJ**' in Delhi for ensuring that children of inhabitant migratory population do not drop out of safety net of formal and private system of education. Through this kind of establishments, the organization caters to the migratory floating population who has travelled from their native to an alien place in search of employment and better life for their children. Guided learning practices, after school support and working on the learning gaps are some of the key educational strategies chosen for this project.



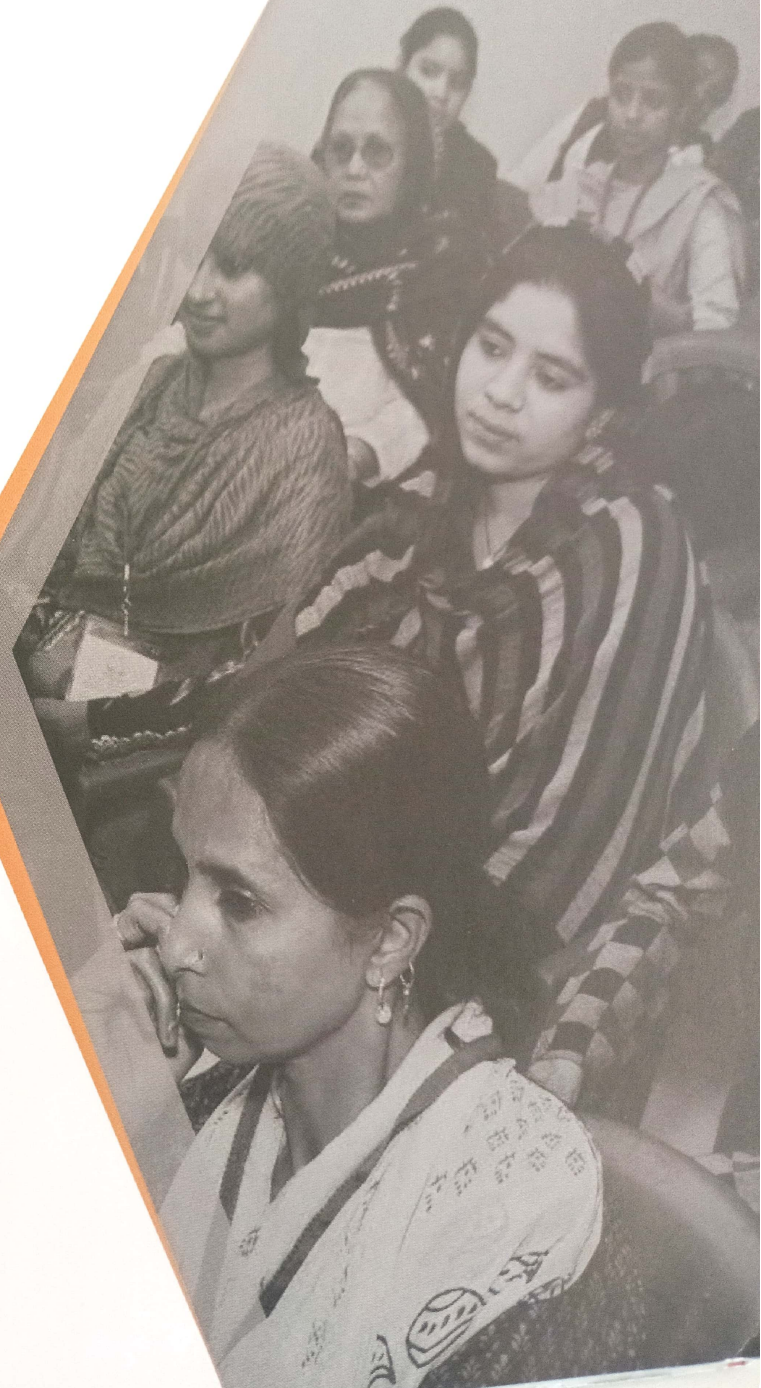


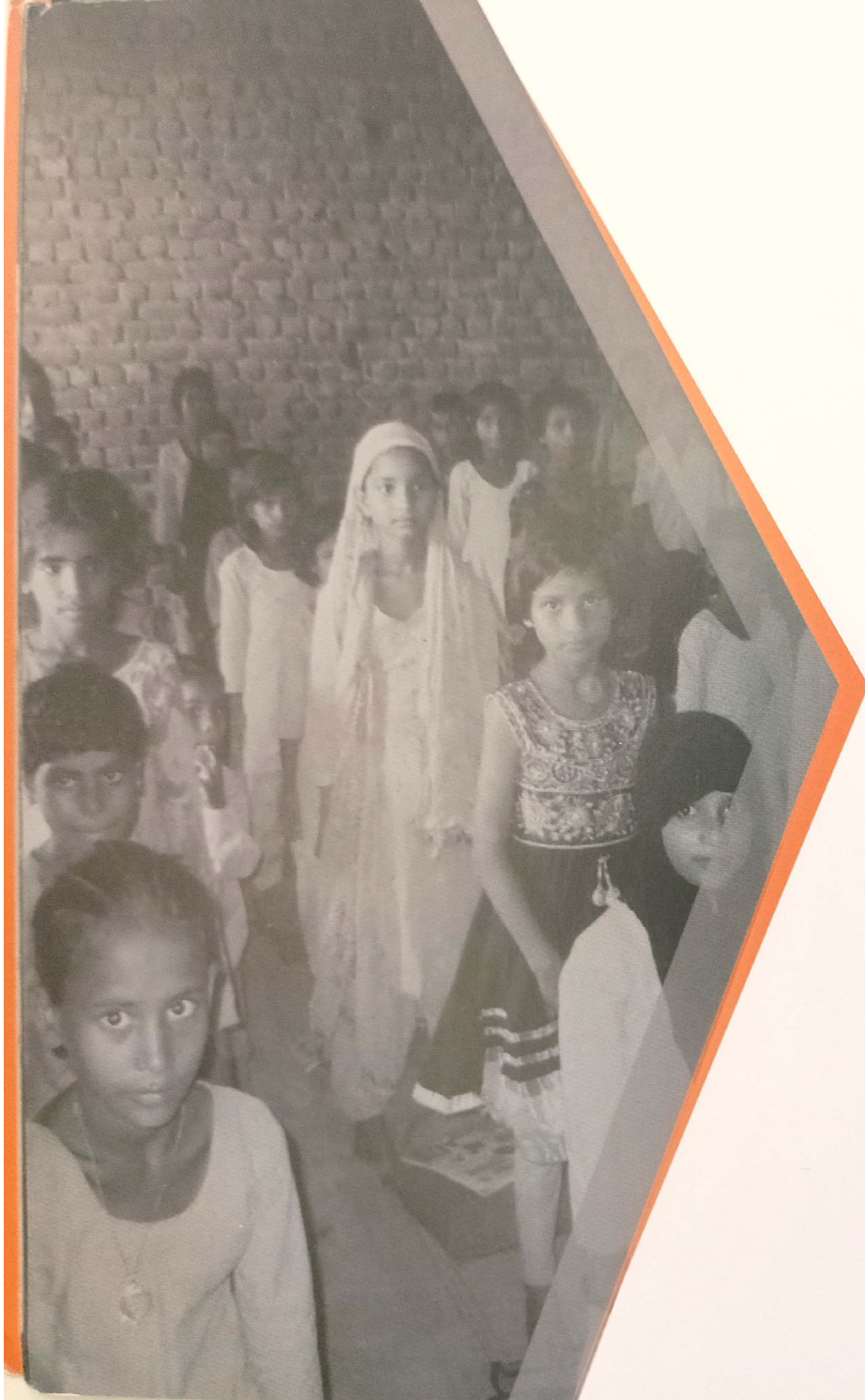
ENABLEMENT

In order to Enable students and youth to equip themselves with education, AICWETE runs various scholarship, life skills, career counselling through psychometric analysis and career choice guidance programmes also. Meritorious scholarships for deserving students is also provided by AICWETE to support students to overcome the financial constraints for pursuing their future dream education and pursue desired career path. The resultant effect of the initiatives got visible when some of the beneficiaries got enrolled in reputed institutions for courses such as Microbiology, engineering, legal, medical and teacher education.

EMPOWERING

Empowering through skill development is one of the niche areas chosen by the organisation as its modus operandi for supporting poor adolescent girls and women. The organisation has been engaged in the skill building training projects even for those women who do not have any sort of formal education or have lesser credentials to become economically independent. Through the scheme of micro finance, it helps women in various parts of Delhi particularly in Jamia Nagar to Establish themselves as self-employable entrepreneurs. Vocational training in stitching, sewing, handicrafts, beauty culture, computer training, soft-skills, corporate management work etc. has helped hundreds and thousands women earn by getting associated with small scale industry/ business houses. The organisation is also helping these women to get oriented about the latest market trends in Indian Apparels and jewelry.





AICWETE's work during the conflict and disaster

The organisation has also worked extensively in disaster and conflict laden areas for relief and rehabilitation in coordination with local government and community based organisations of Assam, Jammu & Kashmir. The programme

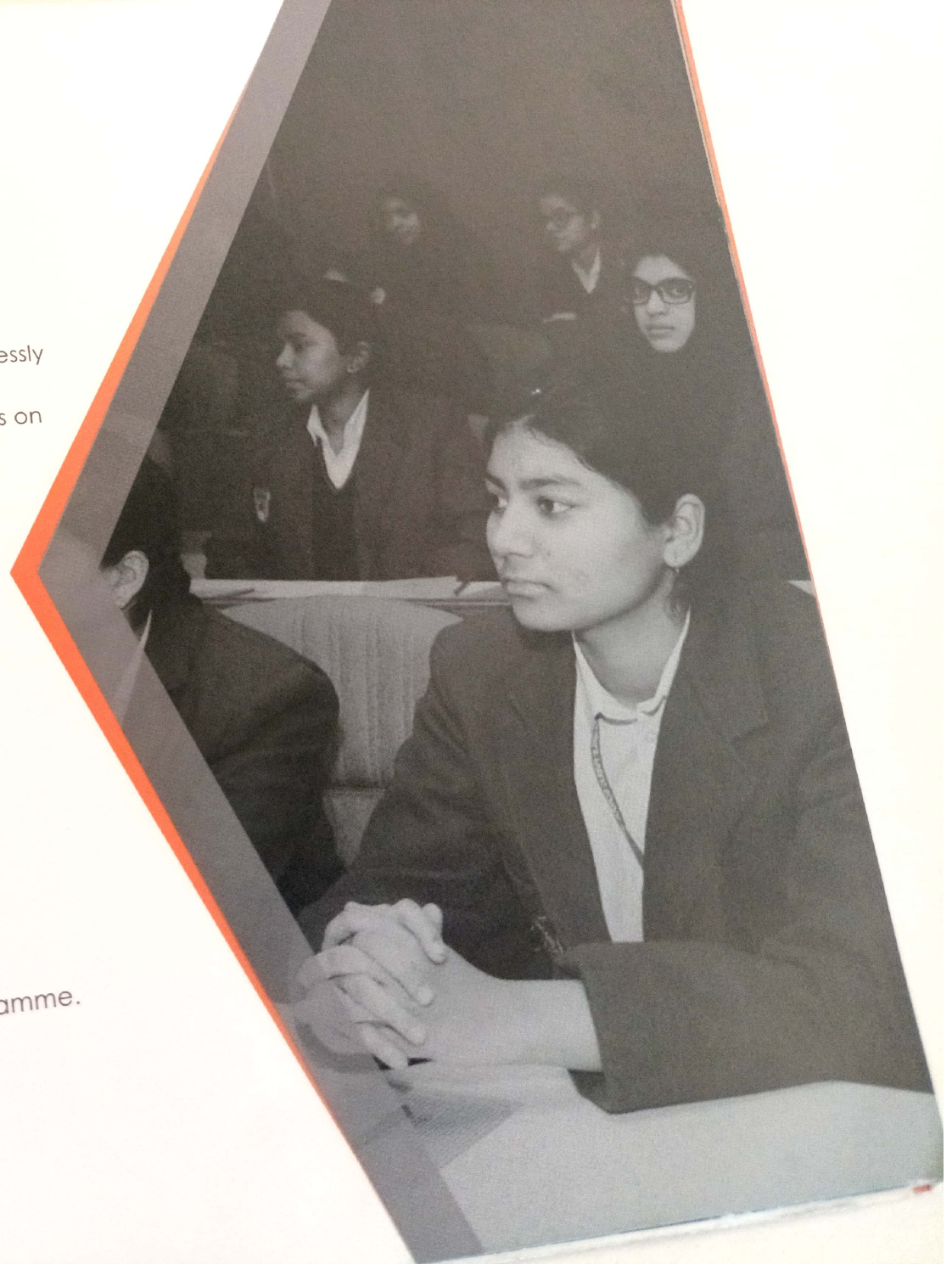
'Educational Rehabilitation of Strife Affected Students' in several districts of Assam was aimed to provide financial aid to continue studies: Scholarships were distributed to students affected by the strife. Adoption of educational institutions of Primary to Higher Secondary was also done under the same programme wherein rehabilitation of 450 students up to secondary level was taken up in different parts of the state and an amount of more than 1.5 crores was spent as a support for education. One degree college, Khairun Neesa Women Degree College at Badarpur, District Karimganj, Assam was also supported for a long time in association with ERD Foundation mainly for the children who were strife victims.

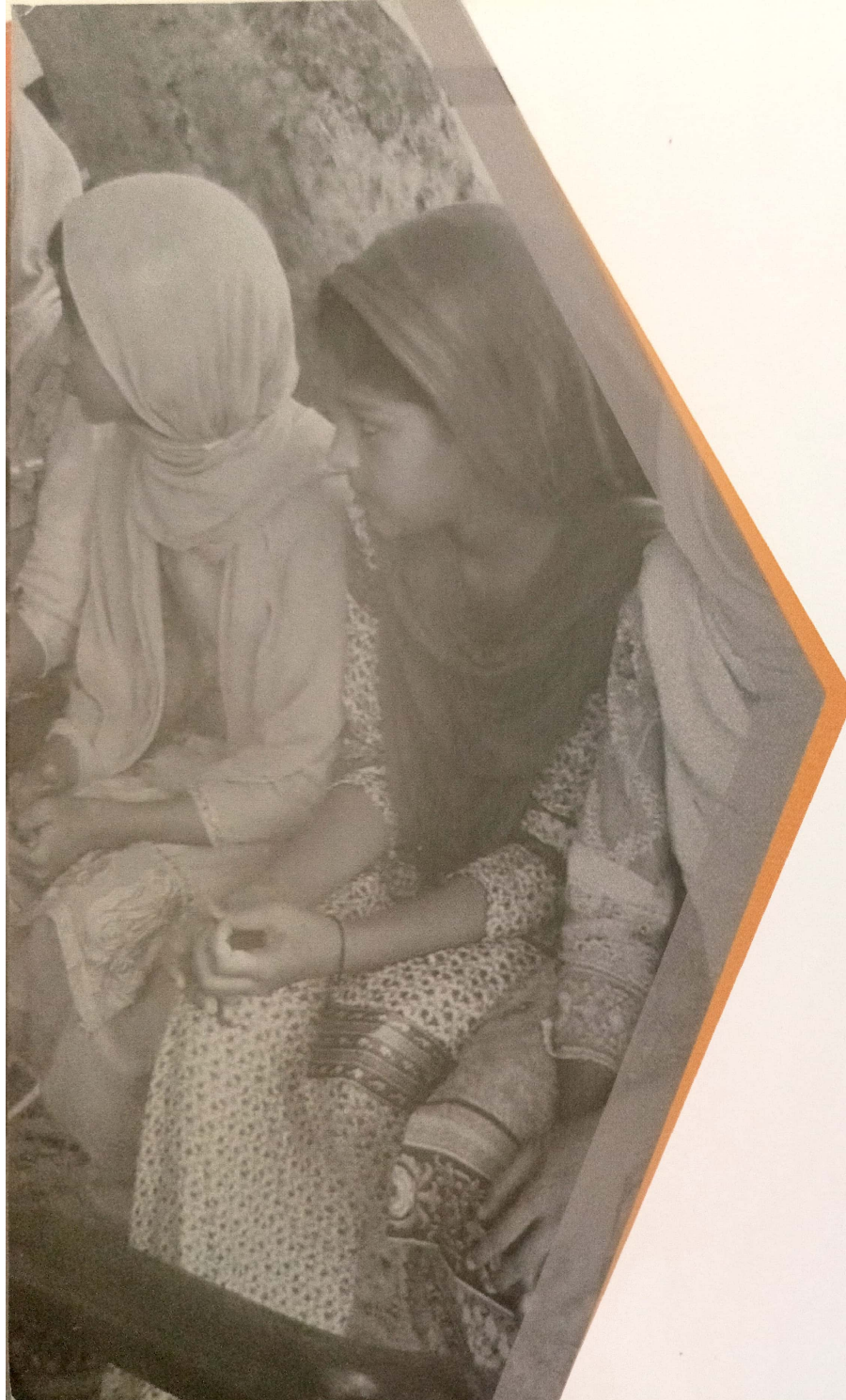
During the flood in Kashmir, a disaster relief programme was initiated subsequent to which a rehabilitation project was launched for continuing support to education. Temporary learning/ education centres (makeshift schools) were established and learning material/kits including school bags, uniform were distributed for children. Children clubs were also set up to ensure that affected children are brought back to normalcy through several catharsis based educational and personality development programmes.

Digital Education in Jammu and Kashmir

AICWETE, Chairperson, Dr. Shabistan Gaffar being an active social development worker herself has contributed enormously in the field of education and empowerment. She, along with her young vibrant team is working relentlessly for education, skilling and digital education and health. She had conducted and supervised several programmes on digital education in the conflict affected zones of Jammu and Kashmir which is also her native place.

A programme '**Rural Digital Education Mission**' certified through DOEACC, Indian Ministry of Communications and Information Technology was an important initiative managed by Dr. Shabistan Gaffar. The programme was supported by both State as well as the Central government. Under the programme, one year diploma in multilingual DTP programme was offered with the help of NCPUL, Ministry of Human Resource Development. The programme reaching out to 12 districts and 10000 youths catered to the marginalized population mainly SCs, STs, OBC and economically backward communities. Employment opportunities were also generated to these trained youths under the programme.





The consequence of 'Rural Digital Education Mission' programme was another employment generation programme wherein trained youths were recruited to digitize the manual voter list which was in Urdu. This programme was implemented in 3 districts of Jammu and Kashmir where the digitization process of electoral enrolments was done. This outcome of the programme was highly appreciated not only by the community but also by several government agencies.

E-Literacy Programme - Another major project in the arena of digital literacy was 'e-Literacy' programme implemented in 14 districts of Jammu and Kashmir under the effective leadership of Dr. Gaffar. A batch of 20 junior staff members from various departments of state government were trained along with some other officials in IT department of state government office.

AICWETE working for Policy advocacy and awareness building

One of the strategies for empowering the marginalized groups has been through building awareness mainly in the form of seminars, workshops both at the national as well as regional level. In the last few years, the organisation has reached out to several communities in almost every part of India both at rural and urban level through awareness building sessions and policy advocacy sessions.

In order to reach quality education for all agenda, the organisation has also been working on the teacher training component of education for Assam, Uttar Pradesh and J&K. The organisation has been conducting several teacher orientation and teacher training programmes for teachers up skilling at various levels. This endeavour aimed to enhance the existing intellectual resources to enrich the classroom interactions and bring about a critical change towards quality education.

A seminar on Abolition of Child Labour by Providing Educational Opportunities was organized, in collaboration with Indira Gandhi Social Development Society, West Bengal at Matia Bridge, West Bengal. In this seminar hundreds of women and children affected by exploitation in workplace were addressed by the speakers and made aware of their rights both from legal and social perspectives.



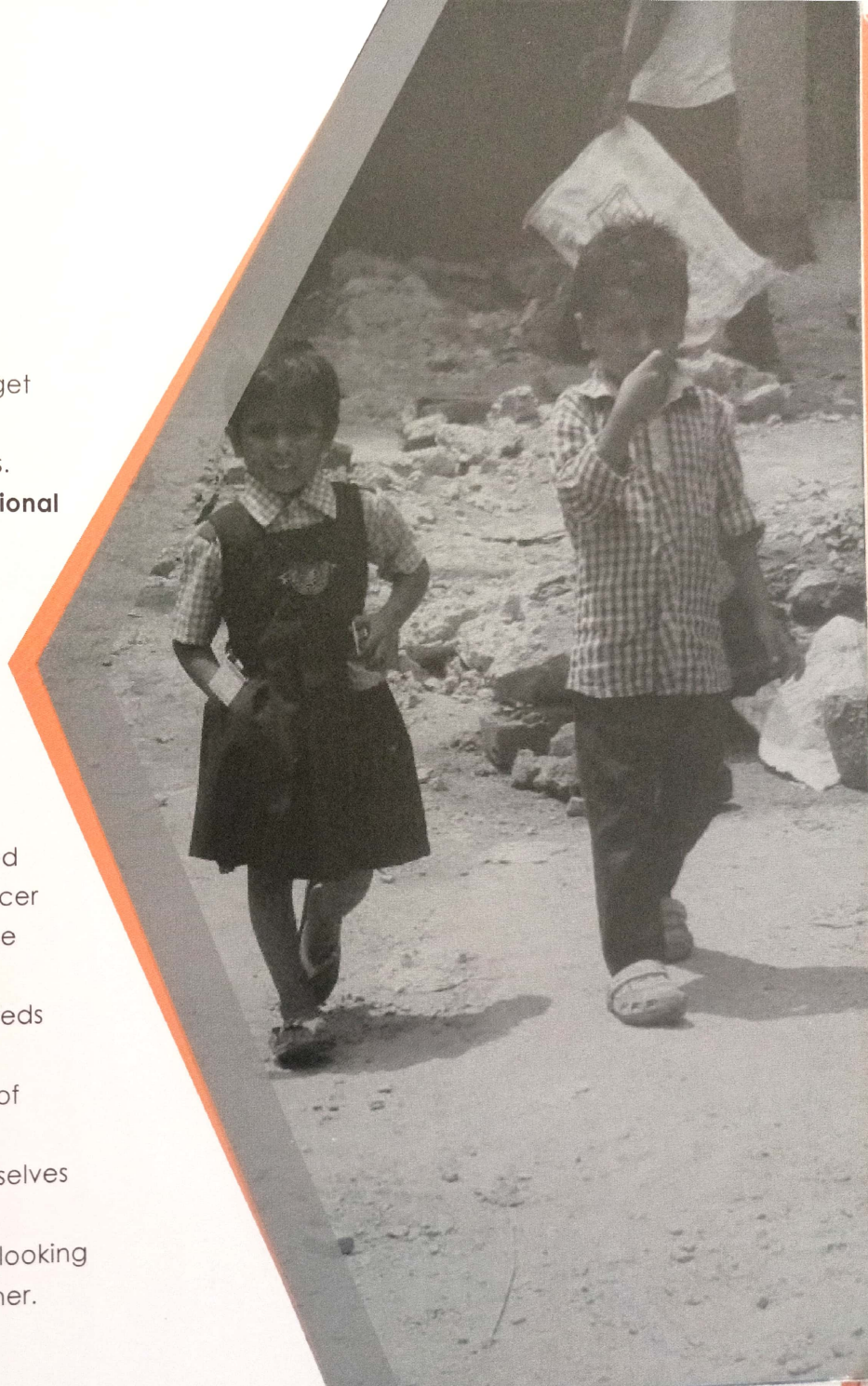


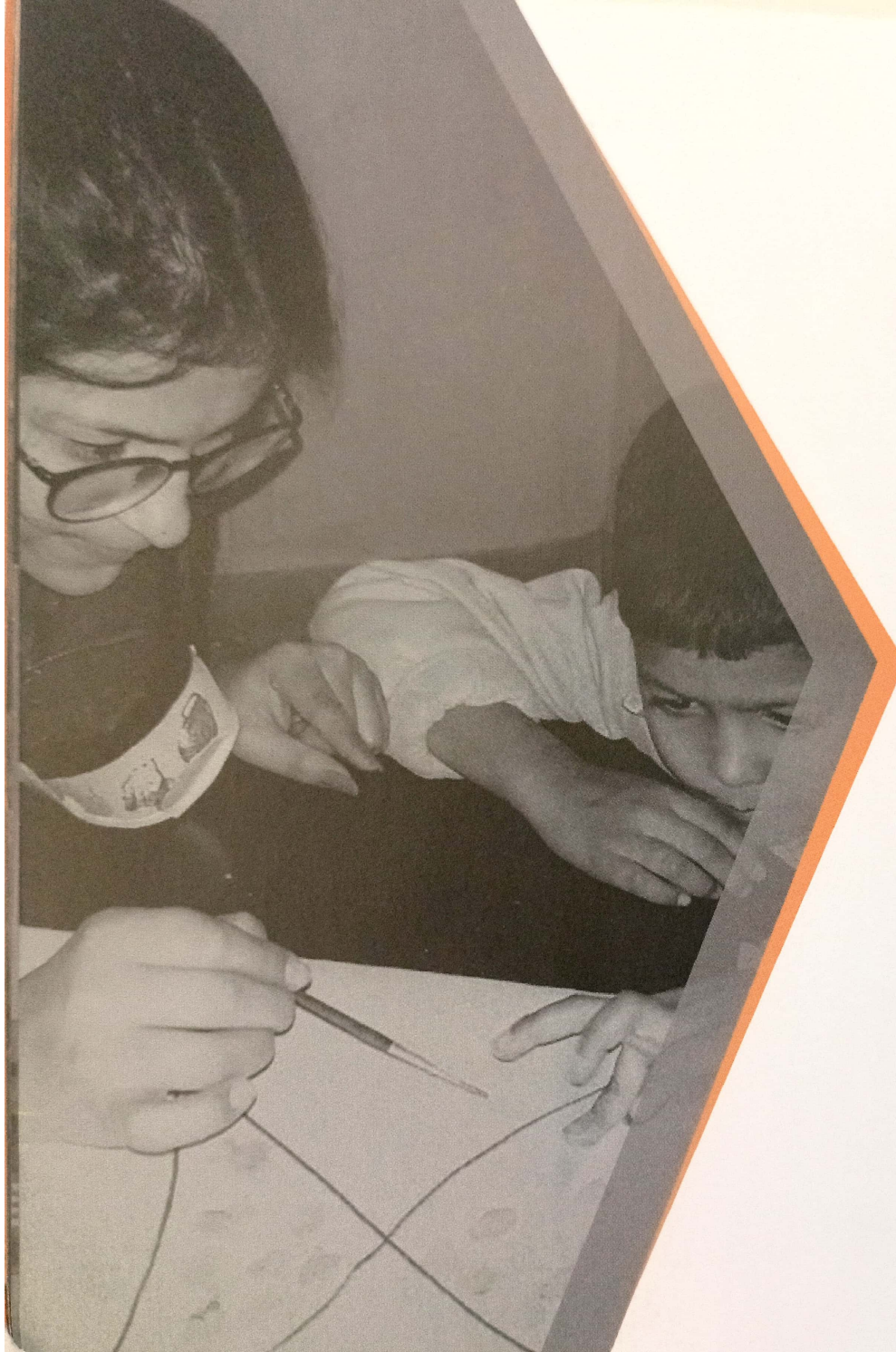
Mass Marriage and Seminar on Women Trafficking- The organisation arranged a mass marriage for trafficking affected rescued girls and run several awareness sessions on women trafficking in collaboration with Jaybeez Sewa Trust, Kolkata and West Bengal for general masses. The programme benefited more than 20 couples and helped several other women to know the root causes, channels, routes and consequences of human trafficking. Under this mass marriage project, the organisation also provided financial support to several families for arranging basic necessities for setting up a household. This project also reached out to some of the rescued girls and empowered them to be back to the mainstream.

National Programme on **"HUNAR SE ROZGAAR TAK-** The organisation conducted a national level awareness generation seminar on **"Hunar Se Rozgaar Tak"(from skill to employment)** at India Islamic Cultural Centre, Lodhi Road New Delhi. Speakers from dignified educational institutions like Jawaharlal Nehru University, Jamia Millia Islamia and several other leading institutions joined the session and addressed women from marginalised groups on skill and employability.

Workshop on **"Strengthening the Self Help Group and its Scalability for larger Empowerment of Minorities and underprivileged women in Howrah"** was organized by the organisation in collaboration with Samaritan Help Mission. In this workshop several Self Help Groups participated to get an insight into new ideas of business enterprising. It also created a lateral platform for sharing ideas and resources. Another national seminar on **'An Understanding of Educational Aspirations and Attainment of Minority Girls in India'** was conducted which was supported by Ministry of Minority Affairs. In this seminar esteemed academicians from various parts of India gathered together to discuss on the issue of educational choices and aspirations among minority girls. Many students also attended these sessions and got benefitted from the deep academic insights.

Breast Cancer Awareness session for women health started by AICWETE to fight against the rising cases of breast cancer is now leading towards getting matured into a project. The organisation feels that creating awareness about the symptoms of early forms of breast cancer can help hundreds and thousands women to fight this disease on a far more successful scale. The seminar has resulted into a thought of setting up women health clubs in several localities where women would meet and create awareness among themselves about health care and will get advice from an expert. These health clubs are in the pipeline, the organization is looking for financial assistance to initiate this in more robust manner.





Our Ongoing Projects

UROOJ

All India Confederation believes that education is essential for development of the child, enlarging the vision about the immediate environment and world. The term Urooj signifies heights. The heights which AICWETE aims to acquire along with kids from deprived background in education.

AICWETE work in education focuses upon:

- Child centered intervention.
- Value Based education
- Joyful and activity based learning
- Critical and creative thinking.
- Catalyzing affirmative change

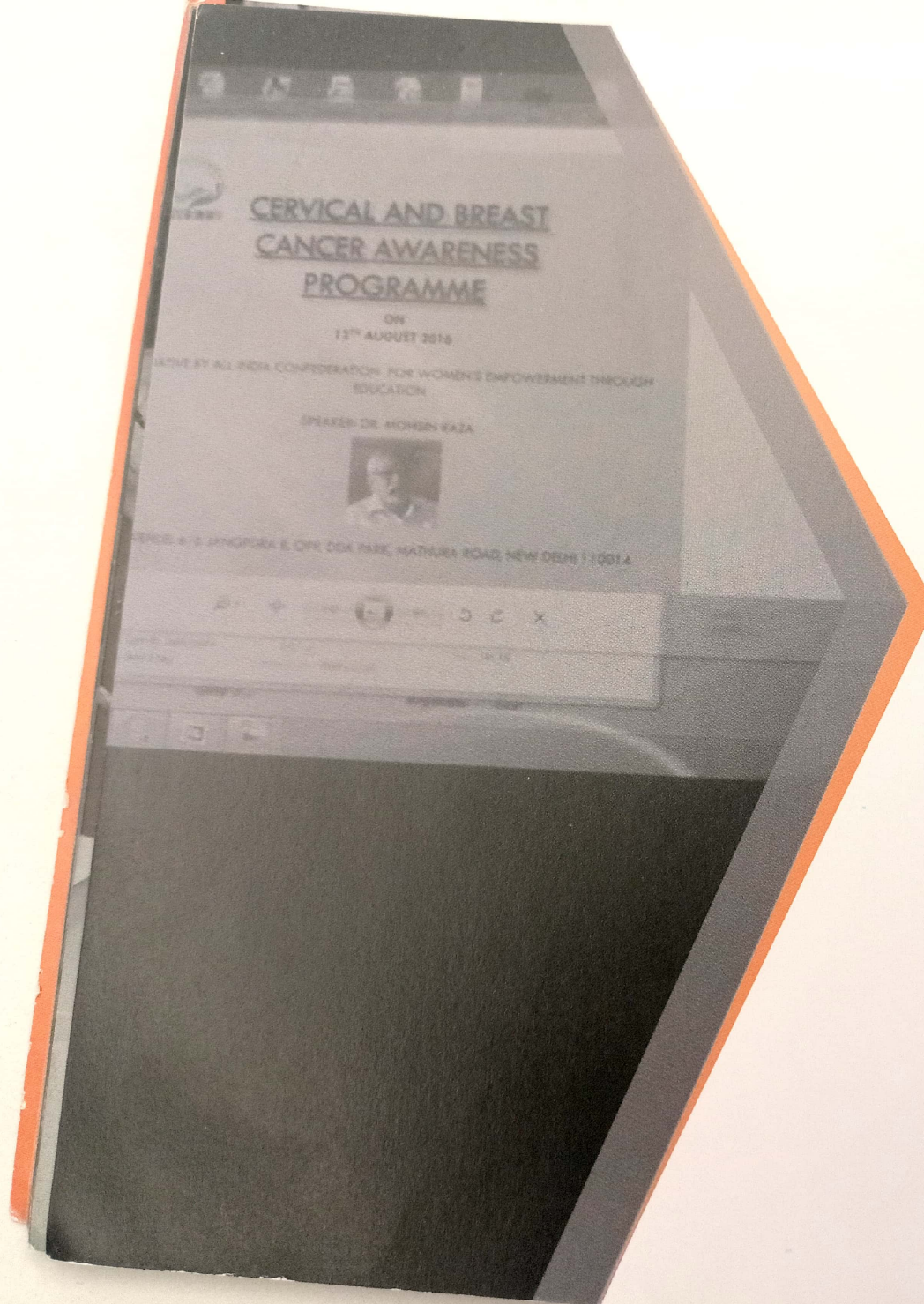
Our Education Program UROOJ offers inclusive education to the children so that they enjoy learning while playing. The program focuses on the satisfaction of the child's curious mind through concept clarity. Our interventions convert everyday into wonderful learning experience by infusing love and care into everyday aspect of learning that leads to All Round Development of Child. Team Urooj works in the area of elementary education through Early Childhood Care , Non Formal Education and Remedial classes interventions to track, encourage and prepare drop outs to retort mainstream education.

HUNAR SE ROZGAR TAK

"Hunar se Rozgar Tak" is an initiative by AICWETE through which it helps women from marginalised sections gain some skill (hunar) to become self reliant through employability (rozgar). It is through skill up gradation we aim to uplift these women and ready them for job market. AICWETE in the last one year has run several levels of programmes to upgrade the women trained in tailoring, stitching, embroidery towards setting up their own businesses. Through the scheme of micro finance women from Jamia Nagar area of Delhi have been helped financially. The resultant output was that most of the women among these were able to open their own boutique at various levels. Another stage of training which AICWETE had with these trainees was equipping them with skills of marketing and further connects with markets national and international.

One of the vision which AICWETE beholds is to upscale these women trained in vocational courses in digital learning also. This is the demand of the day and is well recognized by this organisation. This added training will help these beneficiaries become aware of the recent trends and demand of the market. Thus we focus on evolving marginalized women into self dependent dignified women who excel in vocational, digital and entrepreneurial skills.

Integrated project for clinical services, health awareness and community development of slum people in India

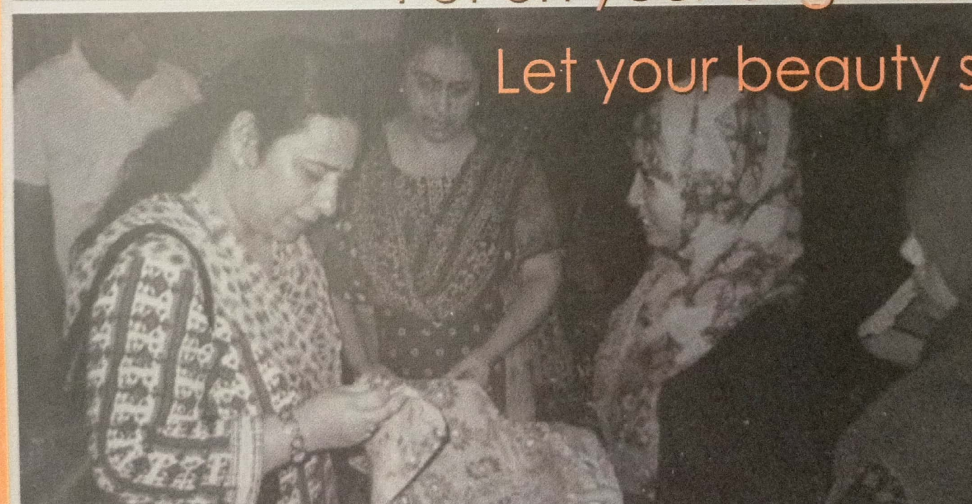
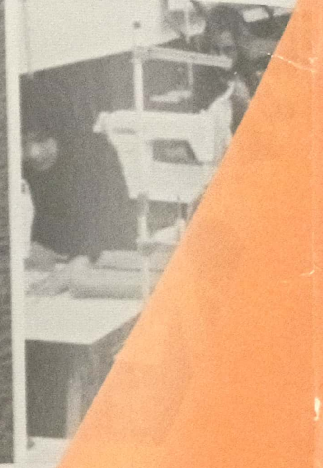
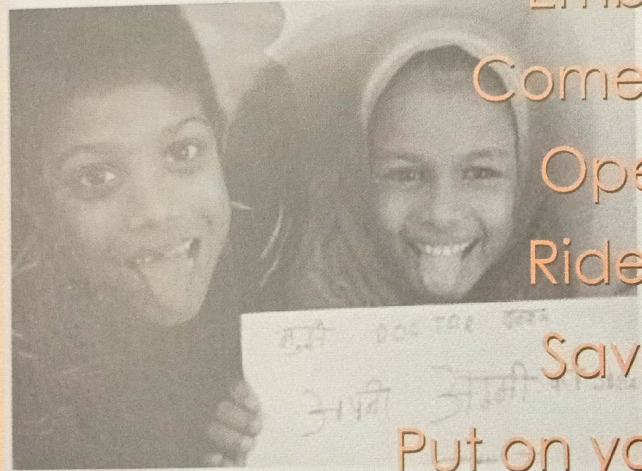
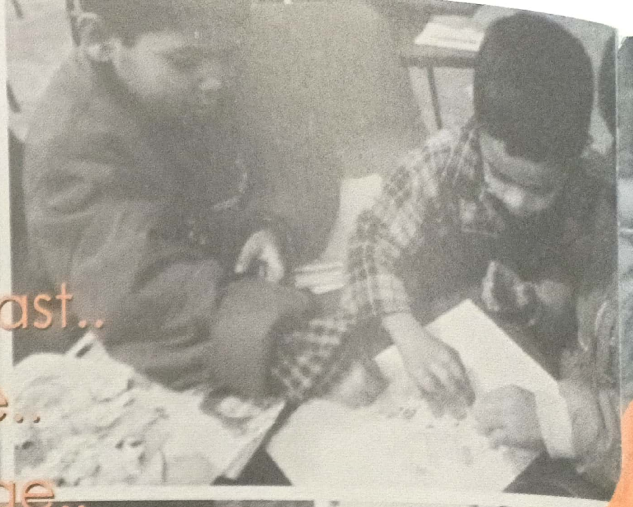
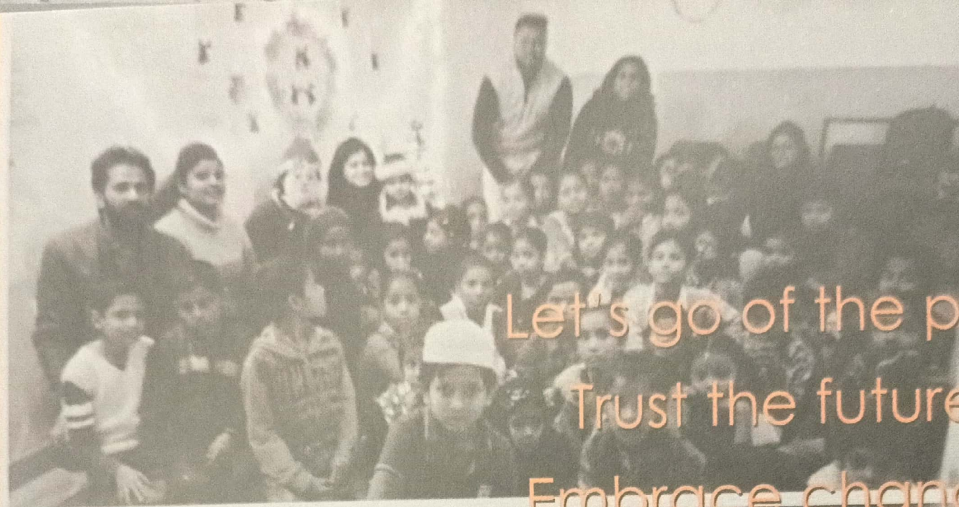
Improving health : Focusing on individual, family and community well- being.

The basic health awareness and needs are lacking for the people living in slums of Delhi .This programme aims toward awareness creation among women, adolescents and elderly about health and hygiene. Through Aarogya we focus is on nutrition, hygiene, sanitation, immunization, Pre Natal Care and Post Natal Care, STI and methods of family planning and providing basic health services to the community. We educate individual and community about various health issues through counseling, demonstration, workshop and seminars to bring about positive attitudinal and behavioural change.

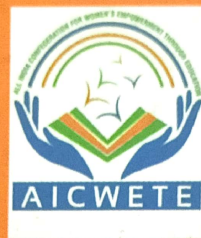
